

Certified Information Security Manager (CISM®)

Course Outline

- Information Risk Management (22% of exam)
- Information Security Program Development (17% of exam)
- Information Security Program Management (24% of exam)
- Incident Management and Response (14% of exam)

In each domain, the various tasks and knowledge statements that a CISM® candidate should understand will be addressed. The course delivery will include case studies, sample exam questions, and classroom discussions.
