

## Control Objectives for Information and Related Technology (COBIT®)

### Course Outline

This two-day course is designed to teach you how to effectively manage business processes and information systems, including enterprise and IT governance, the frameworks, and the industry standards.

This course provides a solid understanding of the major components of IT governance and the specific issues that affect organizations, and how COBIT® addresses these issues with internationally accepted controls and frameworks.

You will be prepared for the official COBIT® Foundation Examination, organized under the umbrella of ISACA®. The Foundation Examination is offered as part of this course.

### Course Content

Students will receive a course textbook that will help clarify what the IT governance lifecycle is, what the principles of IT governance are, and what the management challenges are. In addition all attendees should download the COBIT® executive summary and COBIT® framework 4.1 supplemental reference materials from the ISACA® website (at [www.isaca.org](http://www.isaca.org)).
