



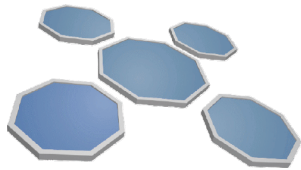

Enterprise Architecture Training using TOGAF® 9

The Open Group Architecture Framework (TOGAF®) is a framework that provides a comprehensive approach to designing, planning, implementing, and governing an enterprise information architecture.

Through the use of a case study, participants will learn fundamental enterprise architecture concepts, as well as how to effectively use TOGAF 9 in real-world situations. This course is intended for IT architects and program/project managers who will lead and execute enterprise architecture programs and projects.

Course Format	Four days (32 hours) of instructor-led, classroom-based training (32 CPEs).
Who should Attend?	Individuals who require a deeper understanding of TOGAF 9, professionals who are working in an organization where TOGAF 9 has been adopted and who need to participate in architecture projects and initiatives, architects who will be responsible for developing architecture artifacts, architects who wish to introduce TOGAF 9 into an architecture practice.
Course Objective	<p>This course covers all of the key learning points for The Open Group's Foundation and Certified levels of TOGAF 9 certification—streamlined and integrated across four days of coursework. The course provides comprehensive knowledge of the processes and content described in TOGAF 9, and prepares participants to take the TOGAF 9 Level 1 and Level 2 certification examinations.</p> <p>The candidate may take the certification examination at a Prometric testing centre, after the course has been completed. Certification is optional and additional fees apply.</p>
Why TOGAF Certification?	IT customer organizations that wish to base their enterprise architecture work on the open, industry standard of TOGAF, will be able to procure tools, training, and professional services on the basis of certified conformance with the TOGAF standards. The existence of a certification program for TOGAF provides an even stronger incentive for organizations (both private and public sector) to standardize on this open method for Enterprise Architecture, and so to avoid lock-in to proprietary methods. It is an important step in making Enterprise Architecture a well-recognized discipline, and in introducing rigor into the procurement of tools and services for Enterprise Architecture.
Prerequisites	A general knowledge of information technology systems is recommended.

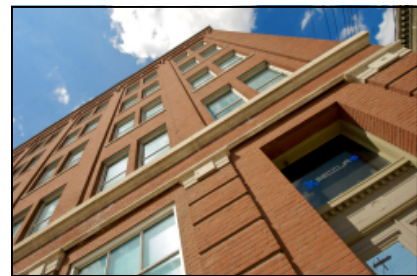
